Who is Christianity Explored for?

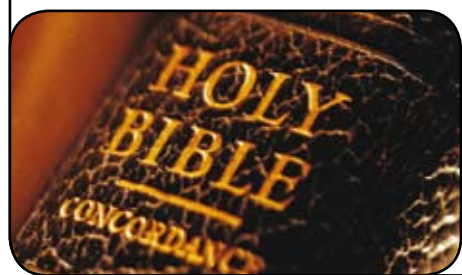
Christianity Explored is for anyone who wants to investigate Christianity informally with a group of other people.

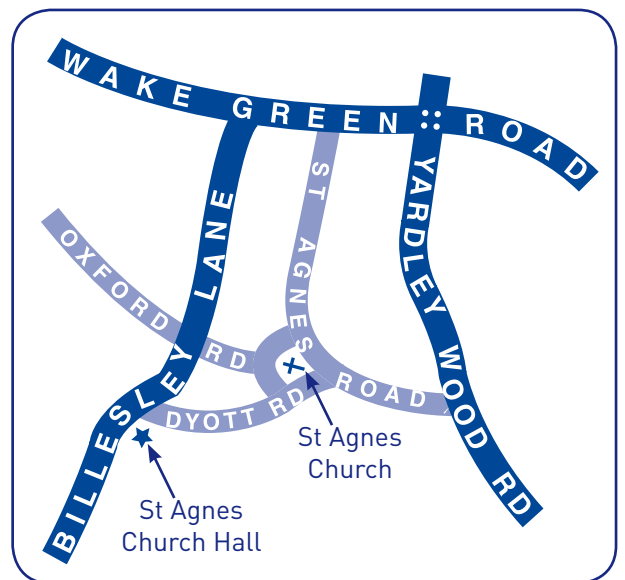
